Any resident, teacher, staff member, parent, or even student may nominate a Shoreline School District student or resident to participate in the Highly Capable testing sessions on February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015 & March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

If your child has already been found to be eligible for the program you do not have to retest. If you have already nominated a student you do not have to do anything.
