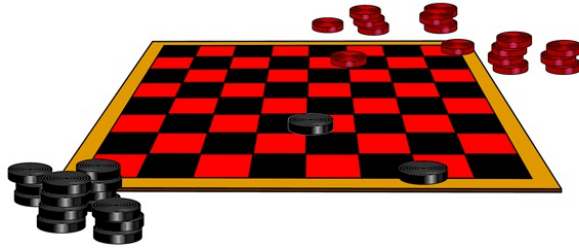

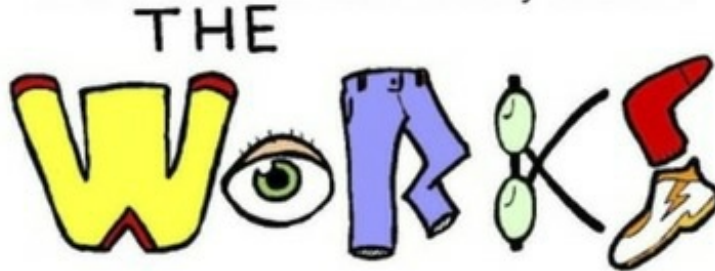
**Checkers and Chess Mania has hit the
