The Shoreline bond: the basics

Information below is from the district's bond information web page:

What it is:

A \$250 million package on the Feb. 14 ballot that would **rebuild Kellogg and Einstein middle schools, rebuild Parkwood Elementary, and consolidate preschool programs** into a new Early Learning Center.

Box Tops Challenge

Let's raise \$2,000 for kids!



Save your box tops and Ballinger Thriftway receipts.

How much will it cost?

Property taxes would rise increase an estimated average of **\$1.19 per \$1,000 of assessed property value** per year over the duration of the bond.

On a \$400,000 home, that would be \$476 per year, or \$39.67 per month.

Why do we need a bond?

Shoreline School District is growing. A recent demography study conducted by Dr. Les Kendrick predicts **our student population will grow by nearly 1,500 students over the next 10 years.** With our elementary school facilities currently at 96.4 percent capacity, additional classroom space needs to be created to provide suitable learning environments for all Shoreline and Lake Forest Park students without overcrowding classrooms. The projects funded by the bond will provide the District with the capacity and flexibility to meet the needs of our growing student community.

Kellogg was built in 1952 and has not been remodeled since 1986.

When would the projects be finished?

The new Early Learning Center would open in fall 2018, the new Parkwood in 2019, and the new Einstein and Kellogg in 2020.
