## 8th grade: It's time to party!

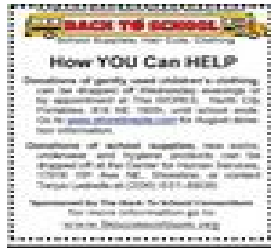
