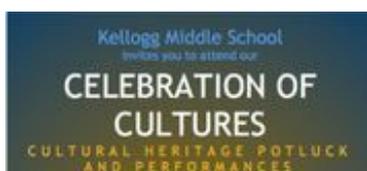


Celebration of Cultures Jan. 18

Show your support around Shoreline

The Feb. 13 ballot is fast approaching, and you can encourage voters to approve the Shoreline Public Schools bond issue through "Rah Rah" events around the district.



What does it take to "Rah Rah"? Groups of enthusiastic supporters willing to smile and wave at busy intersections and other locations throughout Shoreline and Lake Forest Park.

Wear warm clothes, bring "Vote Yes for Shoreline Schools" yard signs and school banners, and raise awareness among drivers and passers-by.

Scheduled "Rah Rah" events are from **6:30 to 8:30 a.m. and from 4 to 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 30 and Monday, Feb. 12.**

The Kellogg community has been a **N.E. 145th St. & 15th Ave. N.E.** as its intersection.

Both the maintenance and operations levy and the technology levy renew existing measures and last for four years. They require a simple majority to pass.

The M&O levy accounts for 20 percent of the district's operating budget and will cost property taxpayers a maximum of \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value. This replacement levy helps fund education programs not fully supported by state and federal funding including special education and highly capable programs; nurses, librarians and counselors; and extracurricular activities.

The technology levy will cost a maximum of 23 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value. It pays for student and staff computers, network servers and wireless infrastructure and software and online curriculum.

Thursday and Friday, **March 8 and 9.** This hands-on science program brings lab-type activities to schools. At Kellogg, all 7th-grade science students will participate.
