DIVERSITY, EQUITY, INCLUSION

As we collectively "celebrate" Women's History Month...let us remember that Black women, didn't gain the same voting rights in the U.S. until 1965! That's 46 years AFTER "ALL American Women" (aka: White Women), fought for & gained voting rights in 1919/1920. That's 4+ decades later & only 57 short years ago.

Asian Women didn't gain voting rights until 1952-but still before Black women. Asian Women/immigrants gained voting rights who arrived in the U.S. after enslaved African peoples (that were forced here centuries prior) before Black women.
